Letter from the Chairman



I am delighted to welcome you to the 36th Astwood Bank Carnival.

Before I tell you about the many great things for you to see and do, huge thanks need to be given to the exhibitors, trade stands, volunteers, and sponsors without whom this spectacular event would not take place. The Carnival has spanned many decades, bringing old and new friends together to provide a valuable event in the lives of the community and surrounding areas. In Astwood Bank we take great joy in continuing the tradition of our annual carnival.

The weekend kicks off on Friday 7th July 2023 at 7.30pm with a Barn Dance in the Marquee on the Carnival Showground, SE Davis, Sandhills Farm, Astwood Bank, B96 6BG. The Barn Dance was first held in 2017 and it has now become a much-loved village tradition on the evening before the Carnival. Last year was a sell-out event with everyone enjoying dancing into the night. This year the everyopular *Life of Riley* will return to provide the music.

The theme for this year's Carnival is 'Astwood Bank Goes To The Movies!', celebrating great movies through the years. The Carnival Royalty will lead a succession of floats, bands and walking groups to the showground at Sandhills Farm. The field will be packed with plenty of entertainment throughout the afternoon, including an amazing line up of arena acts and other activities, such as pony rides, fairground attractions, and the fun dog show (categories including waggiest tail, cutest puppy and best veteran) and static displays. This year's headline arena acts are Stannage International Stunt Display Team and Neil Varney's Twist Mount Gundogs, who will perform throughout the day.

There will be a car display to enjoy, featuring a wide variety of motors from classic through to modern vehicles, and a range of other activities for the family, including pony rides and face painting. In addition, a diverse range of food will be available to buy, including the return of our very popular Pimm's and Beer Tents provided by *The Why Not Inn*. The Beer Tent will host entertainment throughout the day. Take a leisurely saunter around the large shopping area of trade stands where you will find crafts, charity and retail stands, to name but a few.

Rounding off the weekend festivities will be the Carnival Finale, to be held at *The Why Not Inn* on Sunday 9th July, from 12noon, with performances from *David Lloyd the Music Man*, face painting, children's entertainment, with an outside bar and BBQ.

This year, for the first time, we are asking for donations to enter the showground to help meet the ever -rising costs required to stage this event. This decision has been long discussed and postponed for several years. However, we have now arrived at the point where it is unavoidable if the carnival is to continue as the dynamic event it has become.

Any donations received will be very much appreciated as the funds raised are invested back into the community through grants to organisations and community projects, such as the Christmas lights, Astwood Bank in Bloom, and the local Air Ambulance.

We always welcome feedback and ideas so please come and talk to any of the Community Group Directors (all wearing purple high-viz jackets).

I look forward to seeing you all on the Carnival weekend and I hope you have an amazing time.


The popular vintage vehicles area will be displaying a vast array of two and four wheeled vehicles, polished and gleaming ready for display.



Sustainability

Thank you for supporting Astwood Bank Carnival this year, where the focus is on the environment and all the benefits that this brings to the community.

Astwood Bank Community Group is very conscious that, although the environment is loved by all, it needs to be enhanced, protected and it's cleanliness preserved for the future of all. We have set about developing our sustainability policy to ensure that we can be environmentally friendly and drive towards a carbon neutral future.

This year we have implemented the following:

- Cementing a strong relationship with our official waste partner, Bromsgrove District Council, signage around
 the showground emphasises the need to carefully consider waste disposal. Clearly marked disposal bins
 provided by Bromsgrove District Council mean we can maximise the event's waste to recycling and minimise
 waste to landfill. Please help keep the showground and procession route litter free and dispose of waste
 appropriately.
- All of our advertising flyers, brochures and programmes are produced using paper from sustainable sources and, of course, it's all recyclable.
- The event caterers are using recyclable packaging and not using any single use plastics in preparing and serving food.
- The traders are encouraged to use sustainable materials in packaging and selling goods and will also assist in
 encouraging waste disposal in the appropriate way.

CAR PARK

There is a free of charge car park on the showground but remember this will become very busy. The car park is open from 9am.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Will be in place across the carnival procession route. These restrictions allow the procession to proceed unhindered and help to ensure spectator and participant safety. Please help us by keeping the procession route clear of parked cars.

ROAD CLOSURES

A road closure will be enforced during the procession, various roads around the village will be closed for safety purposes. Roads will not be opened until the full procession has returned to the showground.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

This will be affected during the time of the road closure.















Useful Information

OPENING TIMES

The Astwood Bank Carnival is held on the 8th July 2023 and is open from 10:00 – 17:30. This event is free to attend but donations for entry are welcome. Last entry to the event is at 17.00.

CAR PARKING

Parking is available at the showground.

GETTING HERE USING SAT NAV

The postcode most appropriate for Sat Nav is **B96 6BG.** This will take you to the public car park.

DISABLED VISITORS

We have specific parking for our disabled visitors. Please show your Blue Parking badge to any of the parking attendants and they will direct you to the nearest space. Please be aware that disabled parking is limited.

DOGS

Visitors are welcome to bring their dogs to the event as long as they are kept on a short lead and remain under control. Owners are also responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Dogs are strictly not to be left in cars.

LOST AND FOUND CHILDREN

If you lose a child on the showground please report immediately to a steward. Similarly, if you find a lost child please report to a steward as soon as possible. Lost children will be taken to the information point located on the showground. If a child (or other vulnerable person) is found, or reported lost,

immediate contact should be made with any event steward, or the police. Once reported people should wait until an event official arrives.

TOILETS

Toilets are situated at various locations around the Showground. Facilities for disabled visitors are also available.

HAND WASHING AND HYGIENE

It is strongly recommended that anyone coming into direct contact with animals should wash their hands immediately afterwards and, in particular, before eating. There will be hand washing stations located around any livestock area.

EMERGENCY

Should an emergency occur at the event please contact the nearest steward who will be able to assist you.

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited in any enclosed or partially enclosed public area. All cigarette ends should be disposed of once cooled in the bins provided.

FIRST AID

The first aid post is situated on the showground. If you need their assistance at the event, please speak to the nearest steward who will be able to help you.

VETS

We do not have any show appointed vets.

CATERING AND BARS

Numerous mobile catering units are available on the showground. Seating is available. Licensed bars will also be open during the day. Please put all litter in bins provided or take home with you - thank you!

INFORMATION POINTS

Information can be obtained from the entrance gate or from the information point located on the showground.

CASH FACILITIES

To make our traders' lives easier, please try and bring cash with you where possible. Some traders will have access to mobile broadband for card payment transactions but others may not. There will not be a cash machine onsite at the showground.

LOST PROPERTY

Any lost/found property should be taken to the information point located on the showground.

TICKETS

The procession and showground is free to attend with no prior booking required.

STEWARDS

Our stewards are there to help you and will be happy to answer your questions. They are identifiable by wearing Hi-Vis waistcoats and/or badges.

BINS

Litter bins are located throughout the showground for your convenience. Please dispose of your litter responsibly.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers of the event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.



Letter from Rachel Maclean MP

It's hard to believe a whole year has past since last year's Carnival, and in that time I've been working hard on the issues that matter to you here in Astwood Bank.

I know one of the top concerns in the village is speeding along Evesham Road, which is why, over the past few months, your local Councillors and I have been doing all we can to find solutions to this persistent problem.



I can assure you I understand your concerns about speeding along this busy road as I've seen the problem for myself. I've been out with our local police officers and joined them on a speed enforcement exercise along Evesham Road.

I then held a public meeting at St Matthias and St George Church late last year, which many of you attended, to discuss what can be done to tackle speeding. It was made very clear how much of a

problem this issue is and the impact it is having on your lives. Astwood Bank is a beautiful place to live, but speeding is a blight on the village.

As promised following the public meeting, Councillor Brandon Clayton, Councillor Craig Warhurst, Councillor Mike Rouse and I have met with our Police and Crime Commissioner, John Campion, and Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner, Marc Bayliss, to discuss what more can be done to tackle speeding along Evesham Road.



I'm pleased to let you know that a clear plan of action was agreed at the meeting. This is what will be happening:

- The police and highways officers from Worcestershire County Council will be brought together to further explore options to tackle inappropriate driver behaviour and speeding.
- The Police and Crime Commissioner will ensure officers have the resources and tools they need
 to improve road safety on Evesham Road.
- And we have also secured a commitment from the Police and Crime Commissioner to ensure the new 'TruCam' technology is available to local Police to be deployed along the Evesham Road. These are speed enforcement devices which can be deployed in more locations where more traditional speed enforcement vehicles cant access.



I promised residents at my public meeting that there wouldn't just be more talk about this issue, but there would be clear action in tackling speeding in Astwood Bank – and that's exactly what's happening.




