

ROAD CLOSURES

12noon - 2pm, Saturday 12th July 2025

For anyone who is new to Astwood Bank, there is a routine Road Closure through Astwood Bank on Carnival Day, between 12noon and 2pm.

This is to allow the safe manoeuvring of the procession through the streets for the whole community to see. As part of this road closure, we do ask that all cars be moved off the roads completely. This is to ensure access for Emergency Services at all times, as well as the safety of all those participating in the procession and the manoeuvrability of the Allelys Lorries, and some of those turns are tight!!

ROADS AFFECTED

Edgioake Lane, Evesham Road, Avenue Road, Chestnut Road, Hoopers Lane, High Street, Feckenham Road, Castle Street, Church Road.

More reminders, as well as a full procession route map will be shared nearer to the day, but we wanted to thank you in advance for your support.

We try to run Carnival and all our events as conscientiously as we possibly can, thinking of the impact on our village and the wider environment.

The people clearing up from this event are volunteers, friends and neighbours, but we have all got a role to play in this. Therefore, we kindly ask you to use the bins provided to dispose of any waste that you generate. Useful Information

OPENING TIMES

The Astwood Bank Carnival is held on the 12th July 2025 and is open from 11:00 – 17:30. This event is free to attend, but donations for entry are welcome. Last entry to the event is at 17.00pm.

GETTING HERE USING A SAT NAV

The postcode most appropriate for Sat Nav is **B96 6BG.** This will take you to the public car park. As there will be road closures in place, a gentle reminder that cars will need to queue for entry if arriving between 12-2pm via specific roads.

CAR PARKING

Parking is available at the showground.

DISABLED VISITORS

We have specific parking for our disabled visitors. Please show your Blue Parking badge to any of the parking attendants and they will direct you to the nearest space. Please be aware that disabled parking is limited

STEWARDS

Our volunteer stewards are there to help you and will be happy to answer your questions. They are identifiable by wearing Hi-Vis waistcoats and/or badges.

DOGS

Visitors are welcome to bring their dogs to the event as long as they are kept on a short lead and remain under control. Owners are also responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Dogs are strictly not to be left in cars.

LOST & FOUND CHILDREN

If you lose a child on the showground please report immediately to a steward. Similarly, if you find a lost child please report to a steward as soon as possible. Lost children will be taken to the information point located on the showground. If a child (or other vulnerable person) is found, or reported lost, immediate contact should be made with any event steward, or the police. Once reported people should wait until an event official arrives.

TOILETS

Toilets are situated at various locations around the Showground. Facilities for disabled visitors are available. Baby change and private nursing facilities are also available.

HAND WASHING & HYGIENE

It is strongly recommended that anyone coming into direct contact with animals should wash their hands immediately afterwards and in particular before eating. There will be hand washing stations located around any livestock area.

EMERGENCY

Should an emergency occur at the event please contact the nearest steward who will be able to assist you.

SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited in any enclosed or partially enclosed public area. All cigarette ends should be disposed of once cooled in the bins provided.

FIRST AID

The first aid post is situated on the Showground. If you need their assistance at the event, please speak to the nearest steward who will be able to help you.

VETS

We do not have any show appointed vets.

CATERING & BARS

Numerous mobile catering units are available on the showground. Seating is available. Licenced bars will also be open during the day. Please drink responsibly. Please put all litter in bins provided or take it home with you - thank you!

CASH FACILITIES

To make our traders lives easier, please try and bring cash with you where possible. Some traders will have access to mobile broadband for card payment transactions but others may not. There will not be a cash machine onsite at the showground.

INFORMATION POINT

Information can be obtained from the entrance gate.

LOST PROPERTY

Any lost/found property should be taken to Gate A

TICKETS

The procession and showground is free to attend with no prior booking required.

BINS

Are located throughout the showground for your convenience, please dispose of your litter responsibly.

HEALTH & SAFETY

The organisers of the event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accident's occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards.

The landowners, organisers, sponsors or officials of the Astwood Bank Carnival will not hold themselves responsible for any loss, damage, accidents or injury to owners, handlers, spectators, livestock or any property or vehicle, however caused.

Part of the Astwood Bank in Bloom ethos is to be as environmentally friendly as possible and to this end, we use peat free compost in all of the troughs and planters, compost sacks are recycled by using them as liners as well as collecting the waste from our weeding and maintenance around the village, which is then collected and composted by the Council. Most of our 'summer' troughs are wooden, any plastic ones are made from recycled plastic, plant labels are made from recycled

yoghurt pots, where we can. Although we do still use bedding plants in some areas, there are beds around the village and at the Church, that have been planted with perennial plants from the RHS 'plants for pollinators' list. All helps to improve the environment!

We recycle plant pots, re-using wherever we can or taking them to a recycling point. All of our plants are supplied by our local nursery, Botany Bay, with most of them grown there - minimum mileage! We use a lot of begonias as they are really robust in our ever changing weather conditions. At the end of the summer, volunteers overwinter the corms and grow them on for sale at our stalls.

As far as possible Astwood Bank in Bloom are self-funded, we hold various events and sales throughout the year to raise money for plants, compost etc to keep the village looking lovely. We do have one of our 'Bloomer' members who applies for funds for specific projects.

One such project is two 'Friendship Benches' in Overdale Park. A couple of our lovely members, Sarah and Mel suggested it and asked a local fine furniture maker, Ian, to source the beautiful Oak and construct the benches. The principle behind the 'Friendship Bench' is that people who are on their own or feeling isolated, or just want a chat can sit enjoying the views and chatting to people sharing the benches.

The benches and matching planter are a real work of art and well worth a look if you are in the centre of the village (B96 6DF)





Bloom at the Carnival - please come along and say hello to the team, last year the stall was awarded the Best Large Stall at the Carnival!! The Judge made some lovely comments about the decoration and products on the stall.

As with last year there is a garden related fun Tombola, with some fabulous prizes including small garden implements and planted up containers and tubs. Adjacent is the Children in Bloom Activity centre, it's just £1 per child

(note; please supervise your child), we cannot offer creche facilities. There are lots of things for the little ones to do, including a quiet area with books and a tepee.

Later on this year we will run a plant sale at the Flower and Produce Show, held at Astwood Bank Club in Dark Lane (B96 6AS) it will be on Saturday 16th August.

We have a really good selection of fabulous plants, so why not come along for our well-priced quality plants!

It is a really good show with lots of stalls, a gin bar, as well as the Flower and Produce show. One of the highlights is the auctioning off of the flowers and produce for local charities and worthy cause, this usually starts around 4pm.



It might seem a bit early to be talking about Christmas, but Astwood Bank in Bloom will be holding Christmas Wreath making workshops over the weekend of the **22nd and 23rd of November**. It will be held at Astwood Bank Club. Keep an eye on local social media for further details!


